

PNG supply inaugurated on NITK campus

MANGALURU, DHNS: The National Institute of Technology Karnataka (NITK) Surathkal, has adopted the GAIL Gas Limited's piped natural gas (PNG) for its residential quarters and hostel facilities.

The inauguration of the PNG supply at the Brahmagiri hostel mess was organised recently, in the presence NITK Director Prof B Ravi.

NITK In-charge Registrar Prof Kumar G N, Dean (Planning and Development) Prof Venkatesha Perumal, Director (Technical) Pradeep Tanwar, PNGRB Assistant Director (Technical) Arpit Johri, Gail Gas Limited General Manager Sai Sankar and other senior officials were present.

The NITK Surathkal campus has over 20 commercial establishments, including hostel messes and canteens. While the PNG supply had been extended to residential quarters within the campus, ensuring clean and uninterrupted fuel access to individual households, the Brahmagiri hostel mess is the first to transition from LPG to PNG. The remaining establishments are also expected to receive PNG in a phased manner, sources said.
