

NIT-K, Groww provide scholarships to 200 students

The National Institute of Technology-Karnataka (NIT-K), Surathkal, on Wednesday announced the Groww Scholarship Programme for 2025-26, under which Groww, a financial services platform, has given financial help to 200 undergraduate engineering students.

The programme provides financial support to students from economically weaker sections across all BTech disciplines at the Institute, said a release. While 190 students, 158 males and 32 females, received the Well Being Scholarships of ₹70,000 per annum covering living expenses, 10 female students received the Full Ride Scholarship of ₹2.5 lakh per annum covering tuition fee and living expenses.

Students were selected on the basis of academic performance and verified household income. The Well Being Scholarship requires a minimum CGPA of 6.0 and annual household income below ₹1 lakh. The Full Ride Scholarship requires a minimum CGPA of 6.5 and household income between ₹1 lakh and ₹8 lakh. All candidates must maintain attendance above 75 per cent.

The Groww Scholarship Programme is part of a broader industry engagement model at NIT-K Surathkal.
