NITK-GAIL ink pact: Piped gas for all in quarters

Eco-friendly fuel at the doorsteps

THE National Institute of Technology Karnataka (NITK), signed bulk domestic Piped Natural Gas Agreement with GAIL Gas Limited (GGL) for supply of piped gas to all its faculty and staff quarters on its campus in Surathkal.

The agreement was signed by Prof. B Ravi, Director NITK, Surathkal and Sai Sankar B, GM (CGD) Project & Head, GAIL Gas, Mangalore, in the presence of Sudhir Kumar Dixit, CEO, GAIL Mangalore Petrochemicals Limited (GMPL) on May 15 on NITK campus.

A release from NITK said that this pact will enable GAIL Gas to connect all residential quarters of NITK Surathkal with smart fuel of PNG that is economical, easy to use and eco-friendly fuel that will be available at their doorsteps.

This agreement also expands the long-standing relationship between NITK and GAIL, with GAIL being an important campus recruiter over the past years with 20 students being recruited in the academic year 2023-24 alone.

Deliberations during the signing ceremony emphasised the scope for future collaborations on research, especially on safety of distribution pipelines and automation of system monitoring along with possibilities for enhanced internships and employment for NITK students.
